

MISSIONS HISTORY OF SOUTH SUDAN

FIRST PHASE OF MISSIONS BEGINS

First Catholic mission opened in Gondokoro among the Bari but all missionaries expelled by 1882

1851

THIRD PHASE OF MISSIONS BEGINS

Second phase missionaries are expelled and indigenous church begins to grow rapidly

1964

THE PRESENT STATE OF MISSIONS

The indigenous church grows stagnant and missionaries begin to return in the late 1990s with more denominations

SECOND PHASE OF MISSIONS BEGINS

Catholics, Presbyterians, and Episcopalians create "sphere system" to divide mission work

1987

FOURTH PHASE OF MISSIONS BEGINS

Third phase missionaries are expelled and indigenous church begins to grow rapidly again
